COMMITTEE CHARGE:

Advises the Board of County Commissioners on park needs of County residents and visitors regarding County Park facilities. Recommends priorities for projects, including financial and operational development and acquisition. Also provides recommendation regarding long range planning for future park programs and future park needs. Serves as a liaison group representing the concerns of the community with regard to parks.

C. BACKGROUND/ANALYSIS:

Parks Advisory Committee members Steve Davis and Merle Bottge retired from the Committee after serving two terms each. Committee members Damien Gilbert, Catherine Koehn, and Emily Schue completed his/her first terms on the Committee and each wish to serve another four-year term. Both Mr. Gilbert and Ms. Schues' terms expired December 31, 2006. Ms. Koehn's term expired December 31, 2008. Mr. Gilbert, Ms. Koehn, and Ms. Schue continue to be valuable assets to the Committee. Therefore, the Parks Advisory Committee recommends Damien Gilbert, Catherine Koehn, and Emily Schue be appointed to serve a second term on the Lane County Parks Advisory Committee. Mr. Gilbert and Ms. Schues' appointments were postponed until the Board of County Commissioners discussed and decided how they wanted to proceed with future appointments to advisory committees. Mr. Gilbert and Ms. Schue were allowed to continue to serve until such time that a decision was made. The Board of County Commissioners' decision to continue with appoints

to advisory committees as previously conducted allows for the formal reappoint Mr. Gilbert and Ms. Schue at this time.

The Committee reviewed the four new applications received. Interviews were then completed and the Committee recommended unanimously that the Board appoint Barbara Kirchner and Carl Stiefbold to fill the two vacant positions left by Steve Davis and Merle Bottges' retirement. Ms. Kirchner is a local business owner who has served as chair and member of many local business and volunteer groups. Ms. Kirchner's experience serving with these groups and as an equestrian rider will bring a perspective to the committee not currently represented. Mr. Stiefbold background in Ecology and Environmental Science will bring technical expertise that will be useful for the committee during discussions. Mr. Stiefbold is also a sailor and moorage holder at Orchard Point Park, which will help bring a perspective to the committee not currently represented.
