#### I. MOTION:

Move Approval of Order 09 -12 -16 - In the Matter of Awarding a contract for Architectural Services to PIVOT Architecture and Planning for the Public Works Customer Service Center.

#### II. AGENDA ITEM SUMMARY:

The Public Works Department has a requirement for design services to develop a Customer Service Center at the Delta Shops location.

#### III. BACKGROUND/IMPLICATIONS OF ACTION:

### A. Board Action and Other History

Public Works has public interface at numerous locations. In particular, the Land Management Division is located in the basement of the Public Service Building in downtown Eugene. In discussion with the Board the Public Works Director was given direction to pursue developing a customer service center at the Delta location, which would consolidate several customer service sites in one area. The Director also was given authorization to pursue a LEED Silver designation in developing that facility. Management Services developed and coordinated the RFP process with the Public Works Management team. The first phase of the process is the development of an architectural master plan for the project. Schematic design and cost estimates are part of that process in working with the Public Works Management Team.

## B. Policy Issues

Lane County has developed a number of capital projects, but this will be the first attempt at a LEED designated project. By achieving a LEED designation, the County will affirm its commitment to sustainability in developing its capital assets.

#### C. Board Goals

Protecting the public's assets by maintaining, replacing, or upgrading the County's investments in systems and capital infrastructure, and identifying ways to improve space and facilities conditions to better serve citizens, insure the adequate maintenance of existing infrastructure, and provide an environment conducive to high employee productivity, as outlined in the Goals and Strategy B.1.d. of the County's Strategic Plan, will be served by the completion of these projects.

#### D. Financial and/or Resource Considerations

Funds have been allocated for the first phase of the project by the Public Works Department.

## E. Analysis

A Proposal and Specifications for architectural services was advertised, with proposals due on September 2. Fifteen proposals were received. Interviews for the short list of four firms were held on September 29, and the selection committee selected PIVOT Architecture and Planning of Eugene as best meeting the qualifications to perform the work.

### F. Alternatives/Options

- 1. Accept the recommendation to contract with PIVOT Architecture and Planning as the design consultant for the project.
- 2. Reject the recommendation.

#### IV. TIMING/IMPLENTATION

Finalize contract with PIVOT Architecture and Planning for architectural services in conjunction with the construction and remodel of the Public Health Building.

# V. RECOMMENDATION

Contract with PIVOT Architecture and Planning as the design consultant for the project.

# VI. FOLLOW-UP

Upon adoption by the B/CC, a contract will be prepared for signature by the County Administrator.
