AGENDA TITLE: ORDER_____/ IN THE MATTER OF AMENDING CHAPTER 60 OF THE LANE MANUAL TO REVISE CERTAIN FEES CHARGED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY (LM 60.838, 60.839), EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2010

I. MOTION

PRESENTED BY:

Move Approval Of The Order _____/ Amending Chapter 60 Of The Lane Manual To Revise Certain Fees Charged by the Department Of Public Safety (LM 60.838, 60.839), Effective January 1, 2010.

II. AGENDA ITEM SUMMARY

The Board is asked to approve revisions to the Lane Manual related to Department of Public Safety fees. The fees included in this request are set by the Oregon Legislature. In the 2009 legislative session, House Bill 2393 increased service fees listed in ORS 21.410 collectible by Sheriff for serving legal documents and performing other civil duties. The bill was signed by the Governor on July 28, 2009. The new fees take effect January 1, 2010.

III. BACKGROUND/IMPLICATIONS OF ACTION

A. Board Action and Other History

The Department of Public Safety revised some fees in December 2008 (See Order #08-12-16-4). However, the fees at issue in this Order were not changed at that time. Fees and charges included in this request are established by the legislature, in ORS 21.410. In order for the fee increases to take effect, the Board is being asked to approve changes to the Lane Manual.

B. Policy Issues

In general, fees are collected to help cover the cost of providing services with consideration given to keeping services reasonably priced to the public. In the case of the fees for serving legal documents such as summons, subpoenas or other civil duties, the Lane County Sheriff's Office may only charge fees as established by the Oregon Legislature. The fees for these services have not been adjusted for many years and have not kept pace with the cost of providing the services. This adjustment increases some fees, but does not cover the full cost of providing these services.

C. Board Goals

This request for revisions in fees aligns with the adopted strategic plan of Lane County. Section D2 encourages departments to identify and recover user fees and to establish and collect fair and reasonable fees for our services. In this case, the amounts charged for these services have been increased by the Legislature, not as a result of any review by county staff.

D. Financial and/or Resource Considerations

While the proposed fee increases are unlikely to generate significant amounts of money, these small increases will help reduce the gap between the current cost of providing services and the fees that may be charged for the service.

E. Analysis

The Department of Public Safety collects a variety of fees and charges for different types of services. Some of the fees and charges are set by state statute or administrative rule, such as those for Concealed Handgun Licenses. The only fee increases included in this request are those included in House Bill 2393 related to Civil Process.

IV. Alternatives/Options

- 1. To approve the proposed fee adjustments and revisions to the Lane Manual.
- 2. To not approve the proposed adjustment in fees and Lane Manual revisions. To do so will mean that the Department of Public Safety will not be in compliance with the fees established by the Oregon State Legislature.

V. <u>Timing/Implementation</u>

If approved by the Board, proposed fee increases will go into effect on January 1, 2009. Budget adjustments for FY2009-2010 will be processed during the next supplemental process in FY2009-2010.

VI. RECOMMENDATION

The Department of Public Safety recommends that the Board of County Commissioners approve this modification to the Lane Manual.

VII. FOLLOW-UP

Upon action by the Board, Department of Public Safety Staff will work to implement approved fee changes and add the proposed increased revenue to the next supplemental budget process. Existing "Schedule of Fees" have included a notification that certain fees will increase on January 1, 2010.

A minimum fee, equivalent to a quarter of an hour at the hourly rate of the position A006, Secretary 2, Step 1 to include fringe benefits and the indirect cost rate shall be charged for research and time spent copying and/or collating requested information. When requests for information require, in the judgment of the Department Head, the excising of nonpublic information and for research necessitating the use of staff with specialized or professional expertise, or take longer than a quarter of an hour, then the Department Head and/or Custodian of Records will charge the actual hourly rate, as adjusted to include fringe benefits and indirect costs, of the staff personnel assigned to obtain and furnish the requested information.
