## I. MOTION

#### II. AGENDA ITEM SUMMARY

The Human Services Commission (HSC) and the Community Action Advisory Committee (CAAC) of the HSC seek to fill one vacancy in each committee.

## III. BACKGROUND/IMPLICATIONS OF ACTION

## A. Board Action and Other History

The Human Services Commission (HSC) organization has two committees; the Community Action Advisory Committee, and the Human Services Commission with similar but different missions and focuses. The Human Services Commission 190 Intergovernmental Agreement form of governance was established in 1972 to regionally coordinate the administration of human services jointly funded by the Cities of Eugene and Springfield and Lane County through the County Department of Health and Human Services. This entity is responsible for regional health and human services. In 1981, the federal Community Action Anti-Poverty Program, which had been administered separately by the County's Social Services Division, was folded into the fund. In 1984, with the beginning of the Community Development Block Grant program, the cities integrated the allocation of public service funds for social services.

The HSC Board is administered by seven members consisting of public officials under an ORS 190 Intergovernmental Agreement between the cities of Eugene and Springfield and Lane County. Membership is based on the proportion of general fund contributions.

Representatives include at least one elected representative from each jurisdiction. The City of Eugene has three seats and Lane County and the City of Springfield each have two public officials seated on the Board. (LM 3.568)

The Community Action Advisory Committee's has designated slots for recruitment within the mandated tripartite advisory board structure (ORS 458.505)

The Lane Manual allows for twelve members of which a third are public officials currently serving or their designees, at least a third of the members of the members represent low income persons in Lane County, and the balance represent business, industry, labor, religious, welfare, education or other major groups of interest in the community. (LM 3.534)

The two nominees are Lane County designees, one to the Human Services Commission board, and one to the Community Action Advisory Committee of the HSC. These designees are recommended by Commissioner Rob Handy

#### B. Policy Issues

The nominees meet the minimum qualifications for service in this body.

#### C. Board Goals

Meets Board objective of encouraging citizen participation.

#### D. <u>Financial and/or Resource Considerations</u>

None.

#### E. Analysis

These two appointments will fulfill the requirements of the HSC charter and fill designee slots on each committee.

## F. Alternatives / Options

- 1. To appoint the nominee to the Human Services Commission and the nominee to the Community Action Advisory Committee.
- 2. Do not appoint.
