I. <u>MOTION</u>

To approve the Order altering a portion of Stagecoach Road (County Road No. 109) (18-08-07 & 18)

II. AGENDA ITEM SUMMARY

Right of way acquisition and improvements associated with the repair and construction of the road have been completed on a portion of Stagecoach Road (County Road No. 109) (18-08-07 & 18). It is now necessary for the Board of Commissioners to decide whether the completed road project and its alignment should be legally altered.

III. BACKGROUND/IMPLICATIONS OF ACTION

A. <u>Board Action and Other History</u>

Stagecoach Road (County Road No. 109) (18-08-07 & 18) is a Rural Minor Collector established in 1900 as a 40 foot wide County Road, which was altered in 1912 to accommodate the Willamette Pacific Railroad's alignment. Stagecoach road extends from Richardson Road to State Highway 36. The Board of County Commissioners adopted a five-year Public Works Capital Improvement Program for FY 02/03 through FY 06/07 which approved safety repairs on Stagecoach Road. Board Orders 03-9-10-3 and 04-9-22-1 authorized Public Works to acquire necessary right of way which altered its alignment from Richardson Road north approximately 0.75 miles.

B. Policy Issues

The acquisition of property and the construction of a portion of Stagecoach Road (County Road No. 109) was approved as a part of the five year Capital Improvement Program, FY 02/03 through FY 06/07. On April 2, 2003, the Road Advisory Committee held a public hearing and adopted a design concept. Board Orders 03-9-10-3 and 04-9-22-1 approved the design concept and authorized staff to acquire right of way. This project is consistent with Oregon Revised Statute 368, which allows for the acquisition of property, and Lane Code Chapter 15, to provide for improvement, development or redevelopment of County Roads in accordance with the Comprehensive Plan.

C. Board Goals

GOALS

Lane County's Goals

Lane County Government exists to ensure the safety and well being of the people who live, work and visit our communities. That includes personal safety, security of property, preservation of infrastructure, health safety, and assisting in providing for our citizens' basic needs. One such goal is to protect the public's assets by maintaining, replacing or upgrading the County's investments in systems and capital infrastructure. (GOALS, LANE COUNTY STRATEGIC PLAN 2001-2005, Page 13)

D. <u>Financial and/or Resource Considerations</u>

The acquisition of property and the construction of a portion of Stagecoach Road (County Road No. 109) have been completed. Therefore, no additional cost will be incurred as a result of completing the legal alteration of the road.

E. Analysis

The Public Works Director's Report, attached to the Order as Exhibit "B", notes that the alteration and construction of a portion of Stagecoach Road (County Road No. 109) have been completed and the road is open for public travel. The final phase of the project is to complete the legal alteration of this road in accordance with ORS Chapter 368. The Order of Alteration accomplishes that action, including the acceptance of land acquired for right of way as a part of this project. No portions of the former right of way alignment will be vacated by this action. The centerline description of the new alignment, including right of way widths, is attached to the Order as Exhibit "A".

The Lane County Public Works Department has filed County Survey File No. 41581 with the County Surveyor, which includes road centerline and right of way monumentation in compliance with ORS Chapters 209.250 and 368.106.

F. Alternatives/Options

The Board of County Commissioners has the options to:

- 1. Approve the Order of Alteration for Stagecoach Road (County Road No 109).
- 2. Have staff review and alter any component of the Order of Alteration of said portion of Stagecoach Road.
- 3. Continue the motion for further consideration.

IV. TIMING/IMPLEMENTATION

Timing is important, as ORS 368.106 requires that the Order of Alteration and deeds or other documents establishing an interest in real property for public road purposes be

recorded.

V. RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Board of Commissioners approve Option 1. This will approve the Order of Alteration of this portion of Stagecoach Road, as proposed and supported by the Public Works Director.

VI. FOLLOW-UP

Upon approval by the Board of County Commissioners, the Order of Alteration and related attachments will be forwarded to the County Clerk for filing and entering into the Board of Commissioners' Journal of Administration. The Order of Alteration and the road survey will be entered into the County Road Files administered by the Department of Public Works and the County Surveyor for public record.

THIS MATTER now coming before the Board of County Commissioners for Lane County, Oregon, and the Board through adoption of the Capital Improvement Program for the Department of Public Works has determined that it was necessary to alter and reconstruct a portion of Stagecoach Road (County Road No.109). The portion of right of way extends from Richardson Road to the north approximately 0.75 miles; and

WHEREAS, on April 2, 2003 the Road Advisory Committee held a public hearing to consider a report prepared by County staff, and adopted a recommended design concept for Stagecoach Road. Through the adoption of the Capital Improvement Programs for FY 02/03 through FY 06/07 and Board Orders 03-9-10-3 and 04-9-22-1, the Board of Commissioners ordered that staff prepare a right of way plan necessary to construct the road; pursue all necessary planning actions; acquire right of way and prepare plans and specifications for improvement of the Stagecoach Road project; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Works has completed the final road design and acquired all necessary right of way on and over which the project has been laid out; and

WHEREAS, the Public Works Department has completed the construction of the Stagecoach Road project, in accordance with the plans and specifications prepared and administered by the Public Works Director; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined necessary to legally alter this portion of Stagecoach Road, and accept the alignments including acquisitions made as a part of this project, as county road right of way; and

WHEREAS, no portions of the former right of way alignment will be vacated by this action: and

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Works has filed a road survey numbered County Survey File 41581 with the County Surveyor for public record, all in compliance with ORS 209.250 and 368.106; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners is satisfied that necessary road construction and improvements have been completed and will be of public utility and benefit; now therefore, it is hereby

ORDERED, that the deeds, or portions thereof, which lie within the road right of way specified herein, presented to the said Board of County Commissioners through purchase, donation, or agreement, as herein set forth below, on the dates set after the names of the Grantors, and

before the recording information in the Lane County Deed Records, are hereby accepted as County road right of way:

All construction of this portion of road was completed in accordance with plans and specifications administered by the Department of Public Works and the road is open for public travel.

An Order of Alteration to legally alter this portion of Stagecoach Road has been prepared. The Order provides for acceptance of parcels of land and portions thereof acquired as right of way in conjunction with this project. No portions of the former right of way alignment will be vacated by this action. The legal description of the new alignment, including right of way widths, is marked Exhibit "A" and attached to the Order of Alteration.

The Department of Public Works has filed County Survey File No. 41581 with the County Surveyor, which includes centerline and right of way monumentation in compliance with ORS Chapters 209.250 and 368.106.

The public interest will be served by the alteration of this road. It is therefore recommended that the Order of Alteration and related attachments be approved and that it be filed with the County Clerk and entered in the Board of Commissioners Journal of Administration. The Order of Alteration and the road surveys will then be entered into the legal County Road Files administered by the Department of Public Works and the County Surveyor for public record.
