The Board is being asked to approve representatives and designees to various agencies and committees for the remainder of 2010.

### III. BACKGROUND/IMPLICATIONS OF ACTION

- A. <u>Board Action and Other History</u> The Board passed a Good Governance order in January of 2009. The order restructured how and when commissioners would be assigned as liaisons to various committees. Unless such an assignment was required by law, the Order provided for the County Administrator to be designated as the representative.
- B. <u>Board Goals</u> These appointments are consistent with the Board's goals as outlined in the Good Governance Order.
- C. <u>Financial and/or Resource Considerations</u> The appointment process will continue to remove Commissioners from service on committees that they have historically sat on. The assignment of County Administrator Spartz as designee will continue to place an extremely large workload on the County Administrator, both with his assignments under this proposed order, and the accompanying order appointing liaisons.
- **D.** <u>Analysis</u> The proposed order accomplishes the Board's goals yet allows the County to still participate on the various agencies and committees through it's designee.
- **F.** <u>Alternatives/Options</u> The Board could choose to approve the Board Order, or to assign Commissioners to some of the agencies and committees that have historically had a commissioner as the representative for Lane County.
- IV. TIMING/IMPLEMENTATION Effective immediately upon approval.
- V. RECOMMENDATION I recommend the Board adopt the proposed changes.
