I. MOTION

THAT THE ATTACHED BOARD ORDER BE ADOPTED AMENDING BOARD ORDER NO. 10-5-19-4 TO ADD BOB MULLINS TRUCKING, INC. TO THE LIST OF VARIOUS CONTRACTORS AWARDED REQUIREMENTS CONTRACTS FOR THE RENTAL OF HEAVY EQUIPMENT TO SUPPLEMENT COUNTY RESOURCES FOR ONGOING OPERATIONS AND DURING EMERGENCIES CAUSED BY FLOODS, WINDSTORMS AND OTHER DISASTERS DURING THE PERIOD OF JULY 1, 2010 TO JUNE 30, 2011, CONTRACT NO. RM 10/11-01.

II. DISCUSSION

A. Background / Analysis

Over the past thirteen years, Lane County has experienced three major windstorms, three major floods and two major winter storms. Prior to April 1997, these disasters required the Department of Public Works to solicit quotes for additional equipment, including dump trucks, excavators, loaders, dozers and graders in order to meet the needs of repairing the road system and serving the citizens of the County.

The Department of Public Works also has occasional needs for additional or specialized equipment to meet ongoing operational needs in

maintaining roads and bridges and construction activities for other County Departments. Truck cranes, rollers, dozers, scrapers and utility located equipment have been rented from equipment vendors or contractors on a regular basis.

In 1997, the County began soliciting bids for rental of heavy equipment and entered into requirements contracts with all responsive bidders in March of that year. Requirements contract have been awarded since July 1, 1998 with the current contract expiring on June 30, 2010.

Bids were opened on April 27, 2010 and six (6) bidders responded to the request for bids. Board Order No. 10-5-19-4 was adopted on May 19, 2010. Bob Mullins Trucking, Inc. was omitted from the list of those six (6) qualified contractors included in the Board Order. This order will amend Board Order No. 10-5-19-4 to include Bob Mullins Trucking, Inc as one of the six (6) successful bidders.

Upon approval of the Board, it is the intention of the Department to enter into requirements contracts with all responsive bidders.

Sufficient funds are available in the FY 10/11 budget to cover emergency road repair work.

III. TIMING/IMPLEMENTATION

Action today will allow the County Administrator to sign the requirements contract with Bob Mullins Trucking, Inc. as one of the six (6) responsive bidders for the equipment listed in the bid recap as stipulated by the specifications of Contract No. RM 10/11-01.

IV. RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Board authorize the County Administrator to sign the requirements contracts with various bidders including Bob Mullins Trucking, Inc.

ORDERED that the bid from Bob Mullins Trucking, Inc. be included with the above-named contractors accepted as recommended; and it is further

ORDERED that Bob Mullins Trucking, Inc. be included with the above-named contractors awarded contracts for the contract period beginning July 1, 2010 and ending June 30, 2011; and it is further

ORDERED that these contracts be executed in accordance with this Order and the bid specifications and the County Administrator be authorized to sign the contracts.
