WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners, as per ORS Chapter 190, has the authority to enter into intergovernmental agreements (IGA) with other governmental units; and,

WHEREAS, Metro Television is a unit of the Lane Council of Governments; and,

WHEREAS, Lane County and Metro Television entered into an IGA with Metro Television to televise remote meetings of the Board of County Commissioners for the duration of the 2010 fiscal year; and,

**WHEREAS**, the IGA outlined a financial agreement that provides up to \$25,000 for that purpose; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Board of County Commissioners did not require televised services for remote meetings in the amount initially expected; and,

WHEREAS, the re-authorization of the Secure Rural Schools Act is of crucial importance for all residents of Lane County; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Board of County Commissioners is committed to using televised media resources to educate Lane County citizens and other policy makers on issues and services important to Lane County.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that the County Administrator shall undertake an effort to amend the IGA with Metro Television such that up to \$25,000 is allocated for the production, transmission, and other distribution of a video production that outlines the history, importance, and recent developments surrounding the authorization of the Secure Rural Schools Act, including the roles that both the National Forests and Bureau of Land Management's "O&C" lands has played in providing revenue in support of public services in Oregon.
