This measure may cause property taxes to increase more than three percent.

This measure is a renewal with added tax. It is a 5-year Operation Levy that replaces the current levy passed by voters in 2018 that expires in 2025.				
The tax revenue from this measure will allow McKenzie Fire/Rescue to continue to operate at its present level of fire protection and emergency medical services. Examples include continuing the day-to-day operations of the District, providing training to volunteers and staff, and maintaining District facilities, and equipment. Most importantly, this measure allows the District to maintain current staffing levels of nine (9) full-time employees, three (3) part-time summer positions, and the Student Program. The proposed rate of \$1.05 per \$1,000 will raise approximately \$922,845 in 2025-2026; \$950,530 in 2026-2027; \$979,046 in 2027-2028; \$1,008,417 in 2028-2029 and \$1,038,670 in 2029-2030 for a total of \$4,899,509 over a five (5) year period.
