IN THE MATTER OF DELEGATING  
AUTHORITY TO THE COUNTY  
ADMINISTRATOR TO SIGN CONTRACTS  
AND AMENDMENTS ASSOCIATED WITH  
THE JUSTICE REINVESTMENT INITIATIVE  
GRANT.

**WHEREAS**, the Board of County Commissioners is participating with the United States Department of Justice on a justice reinvestment initiative, a comprehensive and supported process to reform state and local approaches to the deployment of justice system assets; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Commissioners the Department of Justice has offered states participating in such reforms targeted grant funding to address specific projects deemed barriers to achieving justice reinvestment reforms; and

**WHEREAS**, Oregon's Criminal Justice Commission was awarded a grant in the amount of \$1.75M which it will deploy in Lane and Klamath Counties; and

**WHEREAS**, the grant funds a three year project within Lane County with \$945,000 of federal money, and

**WHEREAS**, these resources are being used to purchase key human resources within the Office of the District Attorney and County Administration, and

**WHEREAS**, the Lane County Administrator is authorized to execute associated Intergovernmental Agreements and Contracts to proceed with the funded project and be reimbursed through the grant program, and

**NOW, THEREFORE**, the Board of County Commissioners of Lane County **ORDERS** as follows:

That the Lane County Administrator is authorized to execute associated Contracts and Amendments to continue the funded project and be reimbursed through the grant program.
