IN THE MATTER OF CONSIDERING A PROTEST OF  
AWARD OF A CONTRACT FOR COMMUNITY  
CRISIS CENTER SERVICES AND TAKING ACTION  
TO AWARD, REVERSE OR DIRECT STAFF TO TAKE  
FURTHER ACTION

WHEREAS, Lane County recognizes the need for behavioral health crisis services; and


WHEREAS, a Request for Proposal (RFP) process was conducted for a Community Crisis Center; and

WHEREAS, the RFP Screening Committee recommended that ColumbiaCare Services, Inc. be awarded the contract for Community Crisis Center services

NOW, THEREFORE, the Board of County Commissioners of Lane County **ORDERS** as follows:

1. The protest of the process be denied as the protestor did not provide evidence that (a) differing criteria were used to evaluate different proposals, (b) the criteria used to evaluate the proposals did not pertain to the services or products being requested or (c) all higher ranked proposals were nonresponsive
2. Award the contract for Community Crisis Center to ColumbiaCare Services, Inc. for the period March 1, 2016 through February 28, 2017 in the amount of \$829,165.
3. Delegate authority to the County Administrator to sign a contract with ColumbiaCare Services, Inc. for Community Crisis Center services for the period March 1, 2016 through February 28, 2017 in the amount of \$829,165.
