ACCEPTANCE OF A US SUBSTANCE ABUSE AND  
MENTAL HEALTH SERVICES ADMINISTRATION  
GRANT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$2,800,000 FOR AN  
ASSISTED OUTPATIENT TREATMENT GRANT  
PROGRAM FOR INDIVIDUALS WITH SERIOUS MENTAL  
ILLNESS

**WHEREAS**, the County has adopted as a strategic priority the promotion of a Safe and Healthy County; and

**WHEREAS**, securing the grant funds being applied for from the US Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration would permit the County to implement a new Assisted Outpatient Treatment program and expand mental health and substance use treatment services to facilitate the delivery of community-based outpatient mental health treatment services to individuals with serious mental illness that are involved in the public safety system.; and

**WHEREAS**, Lane Manual 20.650(4) requires that the Board of County Commissioners approve the application for grants in excess of \$100,000 if the grant application obligates the County to accept the award as a condition of application.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, the Board of County Commissioners of Lane County **ORDERS** as follows:

- 1) Approve the Health & Human Services application for a US Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration Grant in the Amount of \$2,800,000 for an Assisted Outpatient Treatment Grant Program for Individuals with Serious Mental Illness; and
- 2) Delegate authority to the County Administrator to execute grant documents, including grant extensions, and sign any resulting grant awards.
