WHEREAS, Lane County and City of Eugene have been awarded the FY 2011 Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) in the amount of \$124,360 to fund a portion of the cost of analytical services for the Public Safety Coordinating Council, and law enforcement equipment in both the Sheriff's Office and Eugene Police Department.

WHEREAS, Lane County and the City of Eugene are disparate and therefore split the total grant funds 50/50, thereby providing each agency \$62,180.

WHEREAS, the Department of Justice JAG program awarded the grant to Lane County and the City of Eugene on 22 August 2011.


WHEREAS, Lane Manual 21.137(2) requires the Board of Commissioners approve acceptance of a grant with a value greater than \$100,000.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Board of County Commissioners approve acceptance of the FY 2011 Justice Assistance Grant in the amount of \$124,360 and delegate authority to the County Administrator to execute all related grant award documents.
