
ORDERED that the bid received from Wildish Building Material dba Wildish Sand & Gravel Co., be accepted as recommended; and it is further

I. MOTION

That the attached board order is adopted awarding the contract for Un-Coated Oil & Sanding Rock Materials, Various Stockpile Sites, prospective Contract No. 11/12-09, to WILDISH BUILDING MATERIALS DBA WILDISH SAND & GRAVEL CO., in the amount of \$68,878.00; directing that the contract be executed in accordance with the bid specifications; authorizing the County Administrator to sign the contract; and requiring the contractor to present a performance bond and payment bond in the full amount of the contract.

II. DISCUSSION

A. Background / Analysis

Through approval of the fiscal year 2011-2012 Lane County budget, the Board has authorized funding to obtain rock for use in road maintenance activities.

This contract provides for the furnishing, hauling, and stockpiling of 1/4" - #10 Un-Coated Oil Rock in stockpile, 1,800 Tons; 3/8" - #10 Un-Coated Oil Rock in stockpile, 900 Tons, and all other work and materials as called for in the plans and specifications for stockpiling at various sites throughout Lane County.

The un-coated oil rock will be used in the County's chip sealing program, and the sanding rock is utilized to sand roads during the winter months when the roads ice over. Locating the oil and sanding rock in several locations reduces the expense of transporting material long distances to work sites. Stockpile sites also ensure that the appropriate materials are available when needed.

The un-coated oil and sanding rock could be purchased on an as-needed basis; however, using a private contractor to haul oil rock to stockpile sites early in the year makes for a more efficient operation. This has been a standard practice for many years. During the summer, trucking is at a premium and private haulers may

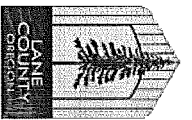
not be available. In addition, using County forces to haul rock long distances to project sites slows work progress. During the winter months it is imperative to have the sanding rock stockpile in order to respond to conditions during periods of inclement weather. The proposed stockpiling acquisition method is more cost effective and helps to ensure the availability of material when needed.

B. Recommendation

Award contract to the low qualified bidder.
