**WHEREAS**, the City of Springfield has requested Lane County's services to provide engineering and materials testing services on projects within the City of Springfield over a three-year period for the 2012-2015 construction seasons; and

**WHEREAS**, under authority of Chapter II, Section 8 of the Lane County Home Rule Charter, it is the policy of Lane County to offer services to other public agencies where feasible; and

**WHEREAS**, ORS 190.010 provides that units of local government may enter into agreements for the performance of any and all functions and activities that a party to the agreement, its officers or agents, have authority to perform; and

**WHEREAS**, the City will reimburse the County for all costs associated with engineering and materials testing services in accordance with Lane Manual 21.124 and the work is scheduled to begin in the 2012 construction season; **NOW THEREFORE BE IT**

**ORDERED** that the revenue agreement with the City of Springfield for the engineering and materials testing services within the City of Springfield be authorized in an amount not-to-exceed \$150,000 and the County Administrator is authorized to execute the agreement and any related amendments.
