WHEREAS, projected budget shortfalls for FY12-13 have led to the need to transition from the current service model provided by Lane County Animal Services to one in which each affected Lane County jurisdiction will be responsible for its own enforcement, licensing and public education with a contractor providing sheltering and adoption services; and

WHEREAS, Lane County, the City of Eugene, and the City of Springfield held a joint public process from approximately March 15, 2012 to April 5, 2012 to gather public input on the development of a Request for Proposal for such services; and

WHEREAS, Lane County, the City of Eugene, and the City of Springfield issued a joint Request for Proposals on April 13, 2012; and

WHEREAS, on the due date of May 21, 2012, the agencies received one proposal from Greenhill Humane Society, which was evaluated by a team made up of two community members and one representative each from the agencies; and

WHEREAS, the evaluation team issued a notice of intent to award on June 4, 2012; and

WHEREAS, in order to provide uninterrupted service to the public as of July 1, 2012, the Board of Commissioners finds it is in the public interest to negotiate a contract with Greenhill Humane Society to provide said services.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED as follows:

- 1. That the County Administrator is authorized to negotiate and enter into an contract with Greenhill Humane Society to provide services consistent with the RFP; and
- 2. That the contract amount not exceed \$120,000 for Fiscal Year 2012-13.
