IN THE MATTER OF APPROVING A CONTRACT WITH  
EMERGENCE, INC IN THE AMOUNT OF \$133,500 FOR RE-  
ENTRY SUBSTANCE ABUSE TREATMENT AND RECOVERY  
HOUSING FUNDED BY AN OREGON CRIMINAL JUSTICE  
COMMISSION GRANT AND DELEGATING AUTHORITY TO  
THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR TO SIGN CONTRACT  
DOCUMENTS

**Whereas**, Lane County Community Corrections Division seeks to reduce recidivism and assist offenders to change; and

**Whereas**, the Oregon Criminal Justice Commission (OCJC) administers the Edward Byrne Justice Assistance Grant program; and

**Whereas**, the Lane County Sheriff's Office applied for a grant from the OCJC to fund transitional re-entry services to include transitional housing and substance abuse treatment for offenders being released to Lane County from Columbia River, Coffee Creek, Deer Ridge or Powder River Correctional Facilities; and

**Whereas**, the proposal was accepted and Lane County was awarded \$333,162 to fund re-entry services detailed in the proposal; and

Whereas, Emergence Inc provides substance abuse treatment to individuals returning to Lane County from state institutions in related Re-Entry service programs; and

**Whereas**, Lane County Chapter 21 sets forth policy regarding signatory authority of the County Administrator:

**NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that the Board of County Commissioners approves the agreement with Emergence Inc. in the amount of \$133,500 and delegates authority to the County Administrator to sign contract documents.
