IN THE MATTER OF APPROVING A CONTRACT WITH EMERGENCE, INC IN THE AMOUNT OF \$133,500 FOR REENTRY SUBSTANCE ABUSE TREATMENT AND RECOVERY HOUSING FUNDED BY AN OREGON CRIMINAL JUSTICE COMMISSION GRANT AND DELEGATING AUTHORITY TO THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR TO SIGN CONTRACT DOCUMENTS

Whereas, Lane County Community Corrections Division seeks to reduce recidivism and assist offenders to change; and

Whereas, the Oregon Criminal Justice Commission (OCJC) administers the Edward Byrne Justice Assistance Grant program; and

Whereas, the Lane County Sheriff's Office applied for a grant from the OCJC to fund transitional re-entry services to include transitional housing and substance abuse treatment for offenders being released to Lane County from Columbia River, Coffee Creek, Deer Ridge or Powder River Correctional Facilities; and

Whereas, the proposal was accepted and Lane County was awarded \$333,162 to fund re-entry services detailed in the proposal; and

Whereas, Emergence Inc provides substance abuse treatment to individuals returning to Lane County from state institutions in related Re-Entry service programs; and

Whereas, Lane County Chapter 21 sets forth policy regarding signatory authority of the County Administrator:

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Board of County Commissioners approves the agreement with Emergence Inc. in the amount of \$133,500 and delegates authority to the County Administrator to sign contract documents.
