



## Displaced Resident FAQ

How can I get a copy of the deed to my property?

- Call or email Deeds and Records. We can provide you with a copy by email, or can mail a certified copy to an address of your choosing. Please be aware that a deed **only** contains a description of the land, it does not include a description of the home or structures. Note that there is a fee for providing copies.

Where can I get information about my home or other structures and buildings?

- Contact the Lane County Assessor's Office at [lanecounty.org/at](http://lanecounty.org/at) or 541-682-4321.

Where can I get copies of my building permit or building plans?

- Contact the Lane County Planning Department at 541-682-4065.

Where can I get information about the property taxes due on my property?

- Contact the Lane County Assessor's Office at [lanecounty.org/at](http://lanecounty.org/at) or 541-682-4321.

Where can I get a copy of my marriage license?

- If your marriage license was issued by Lane County you can get a copy by calling or emailing our office. If your license was issued by another Oregon county, you can get one by calling the State of Oregon's Vital Records office at 971-673-1190. Note that there is a fee for providing copies.

Where can I get a copy of a birth or death certificate?

- You can get copies of Oregon issued birth and death certificates by calling the State of Oregon Vital Records office at 971-673-1190. Note that there is a fee for providing copies.
