Energy Assistance Programs At A Glance

Note: To participate in any of these programs you must income qualify. All payments are once per program year.

LIHEAP - Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program

- Federally-funded program
- All of Lane County, any utility or heat source
- Season begins November 1st while funding lasts
- In office appointments and mail out applications (households with a senior or disabled person)
- Sliding scale payment
- All agencies on reverse side participate

OLGA – Oregon Low Income Gas Assistance

- Northwest Natural-only program
- Year-round program
- Sliding scale payment
- Participating agencies
 - o CCS Eugene
 - o CCS Springfield
 - Campbell Community Center
 - Community Sharing

ERAP – Emerald Rate Assistance Program

- EPUD-only program
- Only for seniors, disabled customers or households with kids age 18 or under
- Season runs Spring to Fall
- Application through mail
- 4 monthly payments of \$75 each
- Managed by Lane County staff

OEAP - Oregon Energy Assistance Program

- Pacific Power-only program
- Year-round program
- Sliding scale payment
- Participating agencies
 - CCS Eugene
 - CCS Springfield
 - Community Sharing

GAP – Gas Assistance Program

- Northwest Natural-only program
- Season begins in December
- Payment of up to \$150
- Participating agencies
 - o CCS Eugene
 - o CCS Springfield
 - o Campbell Community Center
 - Community Sharing
 - Willamalane
