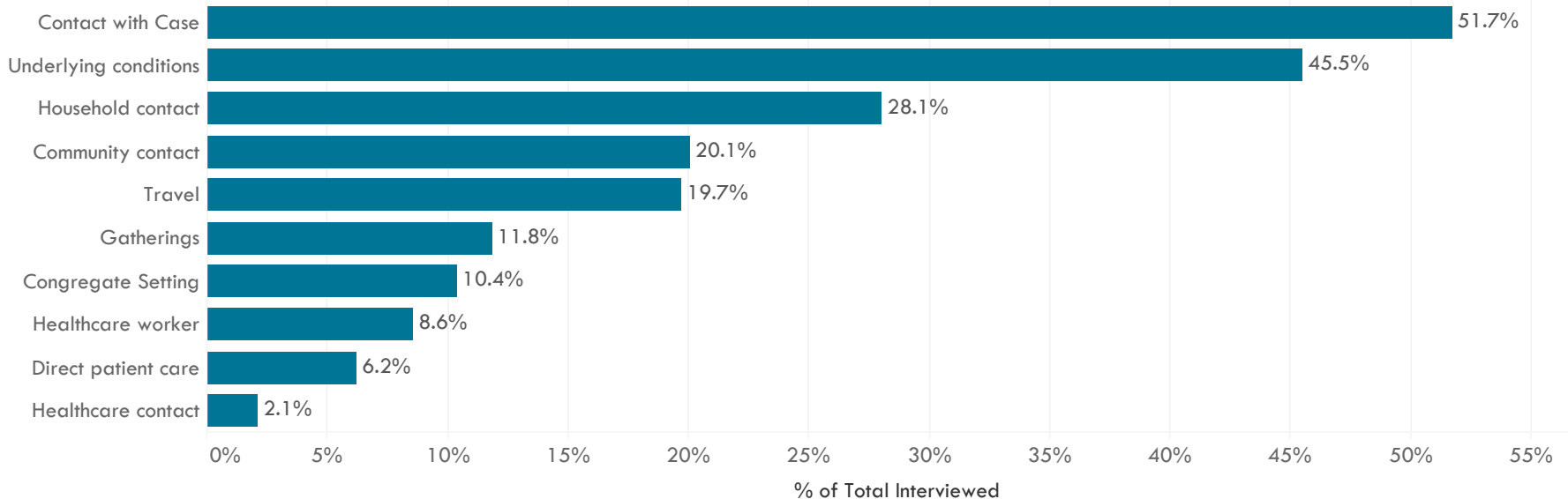
Potential Risk Factors for COVID-19 Infection

A number of factors may influence a person's risk of infection, such as their current health condition, the type of work they do, or their housing circumstances. Those individuals who work in health care settings may be at particular risk due to their proximity to cases. People living in congregate spaces (long term care facilities, dorms, jails) may have a harder time keeping shared spaces clean or maintaining physical distancing. Smoking cannabis causes lung inflammation which may weaken the natural defense in the lung.

Identifying the factors that may put people at increased risk of COVID-19 infection helps inform valuable targeted testing programs.

Note that several of these signs and symptoms were not collected from the beginning of case investigation in Oregon. Also, in some cases we were unable to get an answer due to interview limitations. Therefore, the number of reported signs and symptoms are likely underestimated.

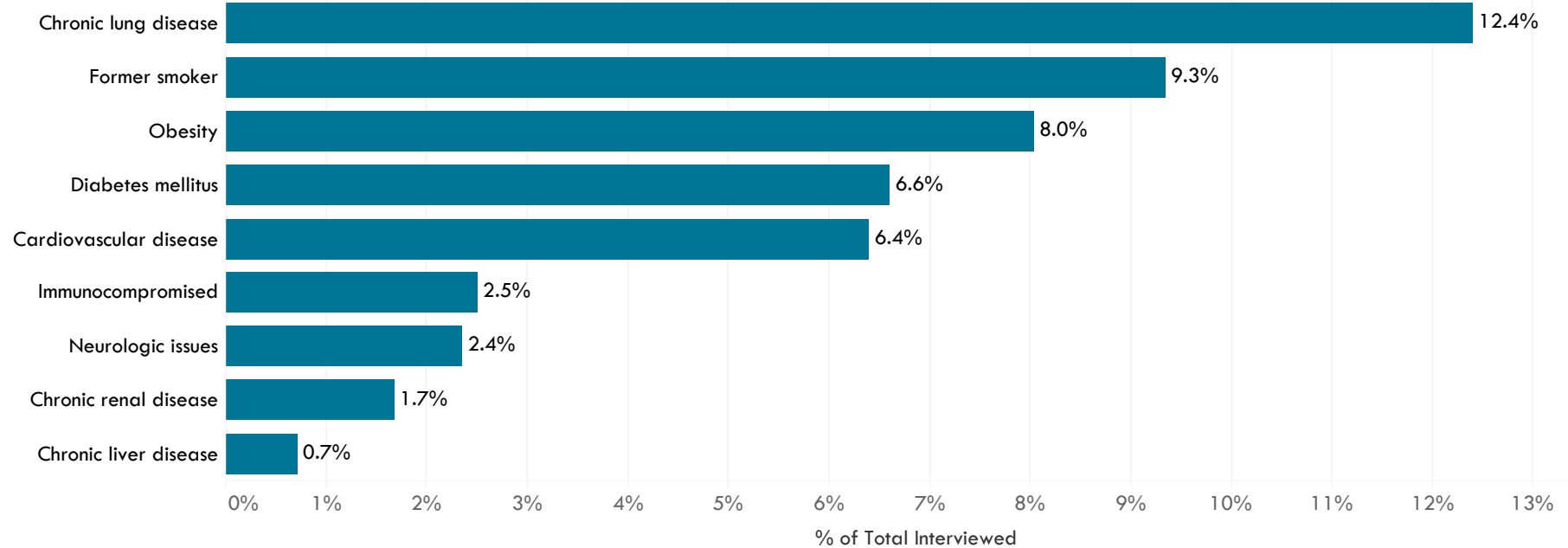

Potential Risk Factors for Severe COVID-19 Disease

A common risk factor for more severe disease in Lane County is having an underlying or pre-existing health condition. (Please see the Hospitalizations dashboard for more on this.)

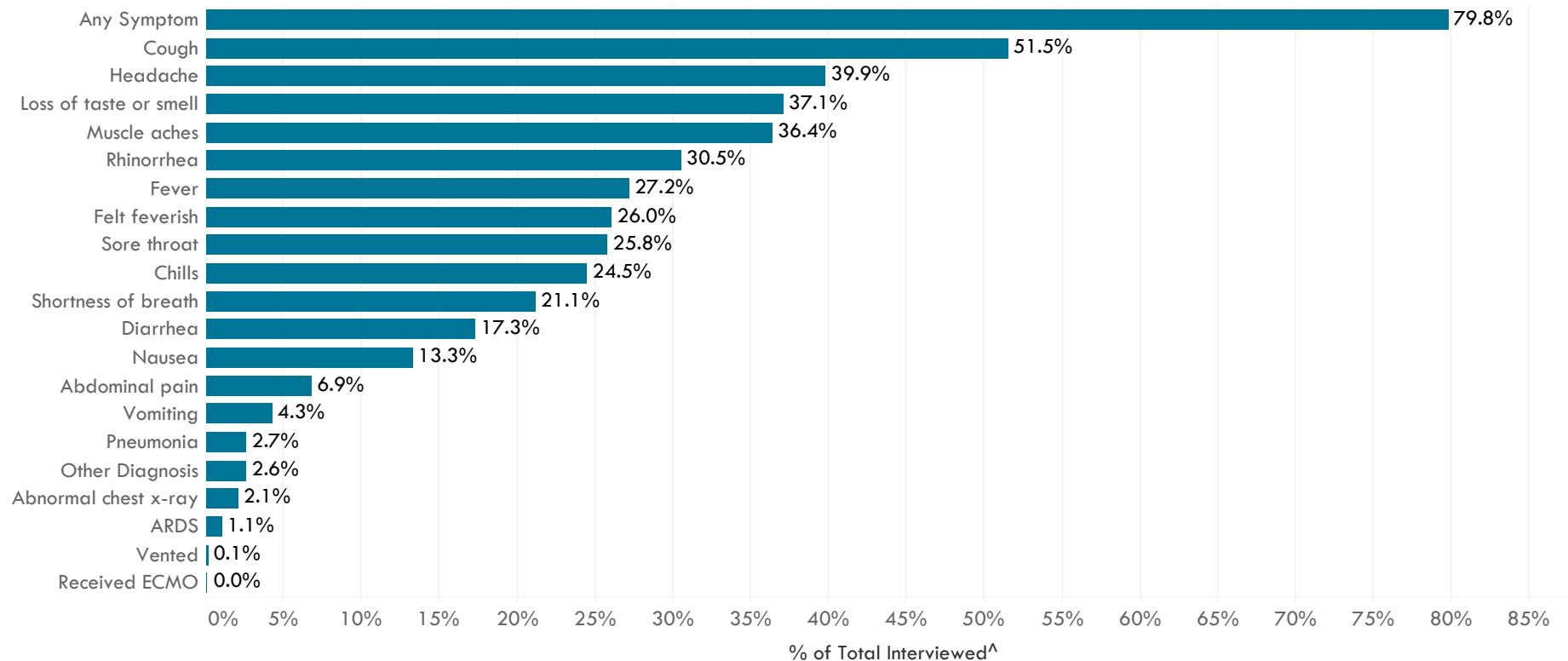
