BEWARE OF COVID-19 SCAMS

Be aware there are many COVID-19 scammers taking advantage of people.
Here are examples of some of the COVID-19 scams:

- Businesses offering vaccines, testing kits, and treatment
- Websites offering stimulus checks reimbursement
- Businesses guaranteeing delivery of out-of-stock medical supplies
- Businesses offering investment opportunities
- Fake charities asking for donations
- Scammers posing as family members asking for money for treatment

DO NOT:

- Provide anyone with your personal information.
- Send any money to an unknown person/business.
- Click on unknown links, visit unknown websites or click on pop-ups while online. This could cause a virus to be uploaded to your computer or device.
