NATURE OF STORY: Assault Suspect Flees Scene

LOCATION: Marcola Road Area

SUSPECT DESCRIPTION: White male, 30-40 years old
Short, dark hair
Medium build
Longer goatee, reddish blond in color
Last seen wearing a white shirt/ dark leather-like motorcycle pants

DETAILS:

The Lane County Sheriff's Office received a report of a dispute this evening shortly after 7:30 pm in the Marcola area. A deputy in the area observed a male matching the description of the suspect shortly after the report. The suspect fled on a motorcycle when deputies attempted to contact him. Deputies pursued the suspect through Springfield onto Interstate 105 and into the Eugene area. He continued into south Eugene near Amazon and Fox Hollow Road where he abandoned the motorcycle and fled on foot.

The suspect is described as a white male around 30 or 40 years of age with a medium build, short dark hair, and a reddish blond goatee. He was last seen wearing a white shirt and dark colored motorcycle pants.

Oregon State Police, the Eugene Police Department, and Eugene Fire assisted at the scene and in the search. We were unable to locate the suspect after a lengthy search which included the use of a K9 Team.

Normal traffic has resumed in the area. We urge residents to contact their local law enforcement if they observe the above described male. Please do not attempt to confront the male. We thank all of the area residents for their patience as we worked to search the area.
