**NATURE OF STORY:** Update: Deceased Identified in Donegal Street Shooting

**LOCATION:** Donegal St., Eugene

**DECEASED:** Michael D. Long, 41 y/o, Eugene

**DETAILS:**

On 7/30/2017, the Lane County Sheriff's Office responded to a report of a dispute at the 2500 block of Donegal Street in Eugene. Upon arrival, deputies discovered a male who had sustained a gunshot wound and was pronounced deceased on scene. The deceased has been identified as 41 y/o Michael Long of Eugene.

Jeffrey Witt was taken into custody on 7/30/2017 in connection with Long's death and lodged at the Lane County Jail on Murder. Witt was arraigned today at the jail.

*Previous release #2, 7/30/2017*

*On 7/30/2017, the Lane County Sheriff's Office responded to a report of a dispute at the 2500 block of Donegal Street in Eugene. Upon arrival, deputies discovered a male who had sustained a gunshot wound and was pronounced deceased on scene.*

*Jeffrey Witt, a 31 year old male, was detained for questioning regarding the shooting and eventually arrested and lodged at the Lane County Jail on one count of Murder. Identity of the deceased is not being released until next of kin can be notified. The investigation is ongoing, and no other information is available at this time. The previous news release is below for reference, as well as a jail photo of Witt.*

*Previous Release #1, 7/30/2017*

*On 7/30/2017 at 11:11 am, the Lane County Sheriff's Office received a report of a dispute at the 2500 block of Donegal Street in Eugene between two neighbors. Deputies arrived and located one male who had sustained a gunshot wound. The male was later pronounced deceased on scene. The identity of the deceased male is not being released until next of kin can be notified.*
