- Pass a background check,
- Must be at least 14 years old and enrolled in high school during Fall 2018,
- Maintain a passing GPA,
- Must be willing to attend the Search and Rescue Academy during the last week of June 2018 to learn the required skills for state certification. Training includes Survival Skills, Navigation, First Aid, Helicopter Safety, and other skills needed to perform as a team member in a lifesaving organization.
