EASCR IS AVAILABLE NOW FOR HOUSEHOLDS IMPACTED BY COVID-19!

EASCR income guidelines are higher than other energy assistance programs. Renters AND Homeowners are encouraged to apply for a benefit ranging from \$500-\$1500!

Applications can be done by mail, email, phone or in person!

You can apply if your household has:

- Lost income from a lay off or reduction of hours
- Lost childcare from school or daycare closures
- Self-Quarantined or are vulnerable to illness
- Or other COVID related impacts

You automatically income qualify if someone in your household currently receives:

- LIHEAP or OEAP from October 2019 – to date
- WIC or SNAP
- Supplemental Security Income (SSI)
- OHP or Medicaid
- TANF or Tribal TANF
- Federal Weatherization Assistance from October 2019 – to date
