For unincorporated residents who cannot take advantage of the County program, there are two local companies that accept leaves and other yard debris for a fee:

Lane Forest Products: 541.345.9085

Lane County's free leaf pick-up service begins November 9, 2020 and includes Lane County-maintained roads with curbs and gutters in Santa Clara/River Road and Springfield. The County will make two complete trips through each area.

Please be a good neighbor and put your leaves on the street less than a week before the scheduled pick-up in your neighborhood. This will help prevent slick roads for cyclists, leaves being blown across the street – or back into your yard – and flooded streets due to clogged storm drains.

Crews may be working in your zone prior to official collection dates. They will return to your zone as scheduled.

Leaf Preparation Guidelines

- Leaves must be in the roadway but piled away from parked cars, storm drains and gutters, bike and traffic lanes, and curbs. Lane County **cannot** pick up leaves in private yards or on sidewalks.
- Leaves are often distributed to local farms, so please keep piles free from other debris such as branches, rocks, metal and lawn clippings.
- Prepare leaves the weekend prior to your scheduled pick-up. Leaves piled longer than one week may scatter and block storm drains.
- Leaf pick-up will be provided for curb and gutter streets only.
- Do not bag leaves.

2020 Collection Schedule

FIRST ROUND

- ZONE A:** Nov 9 – Nov 12
- ZONE B:** Nov 16 – Nov 19
- ZONE C:** Nov 23 – Nov 25

SECOND/FINAL ROUND

- ZONE A:** Nov 30 – Dec 4
- ZONE B:** Dec 7– Dec 11
- ZONE C:** Dec 14 – Dec 18

Remember: crews may be working in your zone prior to official collection dates. They will return to your zone as scheduled.

FREE LEAVES for your garden starting **Nov. 9!**


Two locations!

- At the **Glenwood Transfer Station** (3100 E. 17th Ave) during business hours


Be sure to bring appropriate tools.
